



Head Coach Tips (Head coaches are the people who organize the school's team)

- The online registration is available [here](#). Second team registration begins Nov. 3rd.
- You should be working on selecting your team.
 - Talk to teachers to see if potential SO students are motivated team players, interested in science, and cooperative.
 - Send notes home to families and invite students to a lunch-time meeting to identify a target audience.
 - Conduct a short survey, on Survey Monkey or other online survey platform, to all eligible families. Your school may be willing to e-mail this survey to 3rd, 4th, 5th, or 6th grade parents. If not, send a paper survey home with the students.

- Give some potential S.O. students in your school a chance to try some of the Science Olympiad events. We can help your school organize an Open House event, with demonstration materials, to help generate interest, and to help families understand how they should expect to help.
