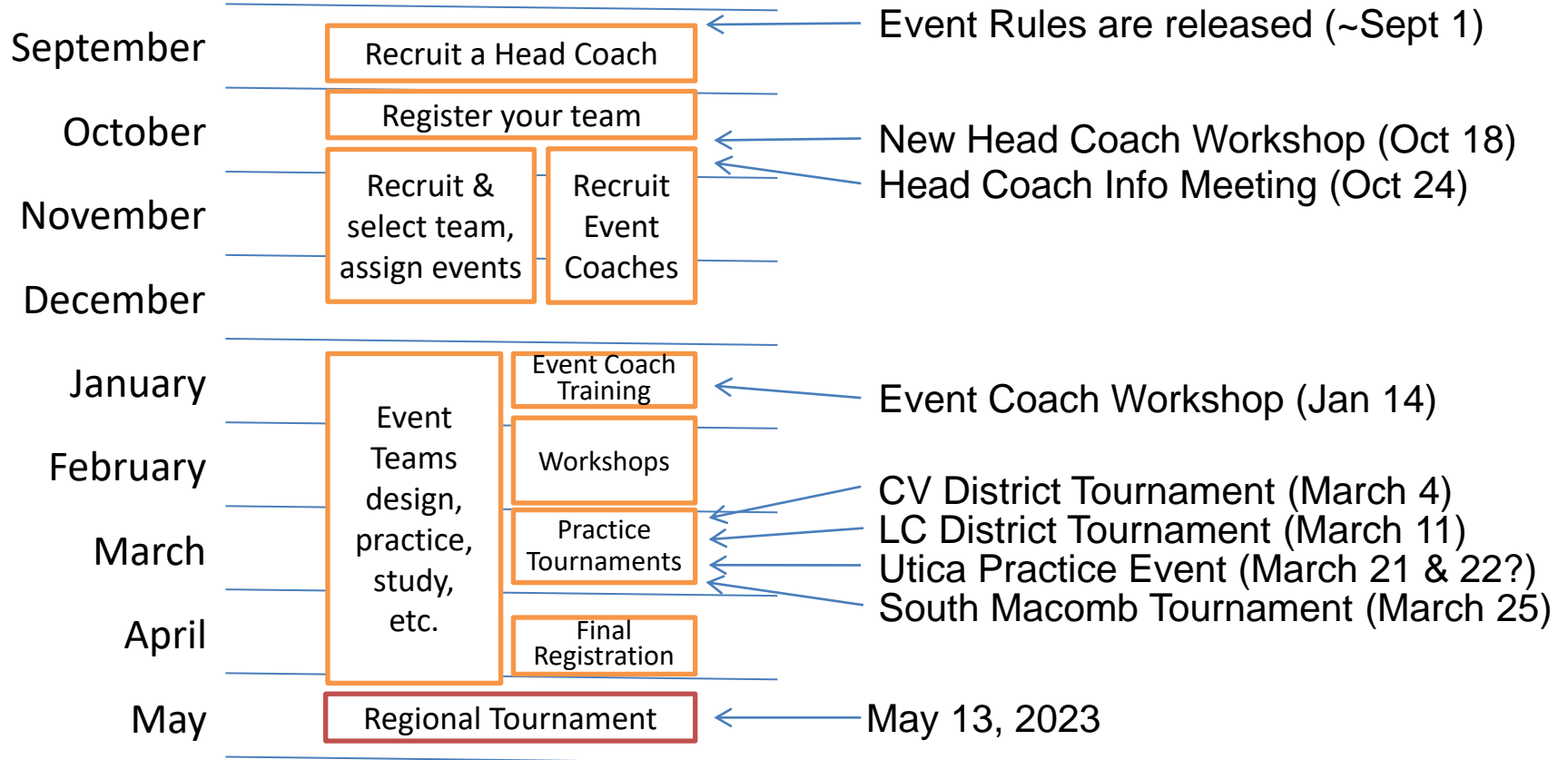


Elementary Science Olympiad Calendar

Important Dates



What is required to participate?

- A Head Coach
- One Event Coach for each event team (anatomy, rockets, etc.)
- Some events require support materials (\$\$)

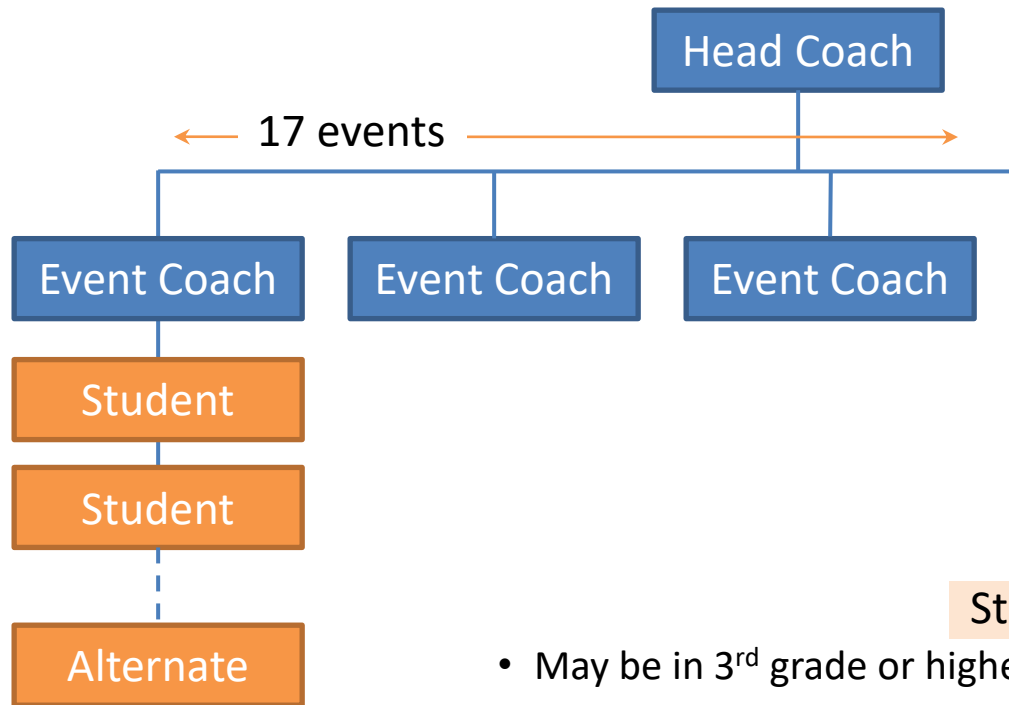
A typical Elementary team budget

- Registration (\$100)
- Team shirts (\$300)
- Event supplies (\$300)
- Coach stipend (district policy)

A successful team has

- Organization
- Accountability
- Enthusiasm
- Continuity from year to year

Elementary Science Olympiad Team Structure



Head Coach

- Recruits, selects, organizes and motivates the team
- May be a teacher or parent

Event Coaches

- Successful teams have high parent involvement; some teams require it

Students

- May be in 3rd grade or higher
- Two students per event team (Reflection Relay requires 3)
- Students typically participate in 2 or 3 events
- Teams may bring up to 17 students to the main tournament
- Practice tournaments typically allow alternates to participate
- Teams which are just starting may want to focus on a few events in the first year, and may have only a few students
