5. Tournament Day Test
 - a. Variety of questions including: labeling models, diagrams, and/or images; matching, multiple choice & short answer.
 - b. Test will be timed stations this year. Probably 3 or 4 questions per station and about 4 minutes per station
 - c. Students are allowed one 8.5"x11" two-sided page of information per team. They are also allowed 2 non-programmable, non-graphing calculators (although I see no reason they would need them!)
6. Study tips
 - a. Make a binder
 - b. Practice tests!! Coaches and students can write tests. Also search internet for tests.
 - c. Invitationals-allows students the opportunity to see questions written by someone other than their coach or teammate. Also can highlight strengths and weaknesses.
